



## BHS PTO PAINTED PARKING SPOT INFO SHEET

**\*\*PLEASE NOTE, YOU MUST ALSO PURCHASE YOUR PARKING PERMIT FROM THE SCHOOL. PURCHASING THE RIGHT TO PAINT YOUR SPOT DOES NOT INCLUDE THE PERMIT FROM THE SCHOOL\*\***

**Hint: It will save you time and money if you pick a spot that was painted last year!**

The only parking spots that are allowed to be painted at the school are those that have a signed, paid contract with the BHS PTO.

### Suggested Supplies:

- EXTERIOR LATEX PAINT ONLY, no spray paint allowed
- Paint rollers, extension handles, brushes, sponges and paint trays
- Painter's tape, chalk, and design template, if desired
- Broom and/or blower to clear space prior to painting. It is recommended to share paints and choose an already painted spot in order to reduce costs.

The approximate dimensions of the paintable area are 197" x 102". Please do not paint on or near the number of the parking space, leave a 12 inch border from the top and sides of the parking spot and around the numbers (so do not paint right up to the sides and the top of the space).

The night before you want to paint your spot we suggest you put orange cones in your spot so you won't show up to paint and someone has parked in your spot. **DO NOT LEAVE FULL PAINT CANS AT ANY TIME IN YOUR SPOT, THEY WILL GET RUN OVER, TRUST US!** Also, after you are done painting we suggest you continue to leave the orange cones so that no one drives through your spot for a day or two. These spots will only be reserved during the school year, during school hours.

## BHS PTO PAINTED PARKING SPOT CONTRACT

PTO is selling permits to paint spots (reminder, student must still buy a parking permit through the school, this contract and payment is only for painting).

This is for 2019-2020 Juniors/Seniors only with Seniors getting a 2 week window to pick out spots first (April 22 through May 6, then opening to Juniors).

Permit is good for a current school year only. If you have previously painted a spot and wish to keep for next year, you still need to pay the \$40 renewal fee.

The student will provide all paint and supplies.
